Structure of the meeting's programme

Relatively few comments were made regarding the format/structure of the meeting's programme. Based on these comments the following recommendations can be made for the organization of the programme of future meetings:

- The current structure will be kept : Consortia presentations, Review talks, Poster session, Thematic sessions organized by Expert Team chairs, EWGLAM final discussion, SRNWP business meeting
- Discussions after the thematic sessions will last for 10 minutes raising the most important related questions and initiating more detailed discussions in coffee breaks. Session Chairs will be asked to keep a strict schedule and to prepare a short note on the continuing discussions if important, which will be put to the SRNWP website together with the presentations after the meeting as a reminder.
- The "3 bullets" will be kept as the main format for giving the national poster introductions
- The meeting's draft programme will be placed on the meeting's website well in advance (July) even if being incomplete and updated regularly as contributions arrive.
- NWP related issues raised by the EUMETNET STAC (Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee) will be distributed in advance the meeting via email so that they can be discussed more efficiently.

Next EWGLAM/SRNWP meeting

The next 35thEWGLAM / 20th SRNWP meeting will be organized in Turkey, Antalya between 30 September - 3 October 2013 (instead of the originally planned 7-10 October 2013 due to the colliding dates with the DWD Data Assimilation Symposium in Munich and the WMO Symposium on Data Assimilation 7-11 October, USA) .
